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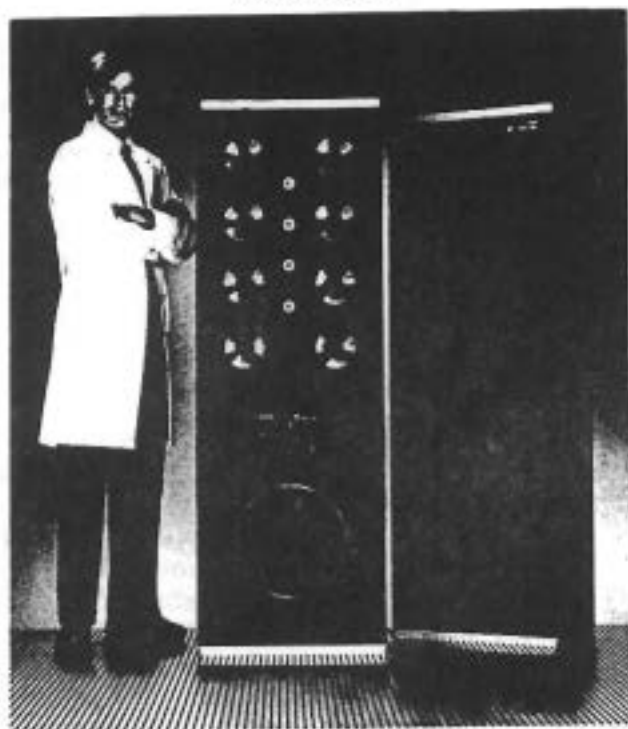

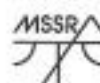

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Given the nature of this publication's constituency, we may be excused for being slightly more parochial than when reporting on a national basis. *Squash News* has already told you everything that you wanted to know about winners and non-winners and how they got that way.

Baltimore (or Maryland, as USSRA likes to call us) has a splendid history of staging national championships, particularly in the area of men's doubles. The 1987 version, arguably among the top presentations in USSRA history, was our tenth; this is more than any other city has staged. We must be doing something right.



Judging from the kind comments that the USSRA and other visitors have made, a lot of things were done right. They were done right by the industrious and spirited committee shown and listed above. The imagination and drive that each committee member put into his/her area of responsibility became apparent when the starting gun sounded. The whole show was smooth and virtually glitchless. As effective as the committee's efforts on the competition and social fronts were, however, they were overshadowed by the superb fund-raising effort led by Tommy and Jervey and participated in by others.

The MSSRA, for as long as most of us can remember, has been in a pauper mode. Some can remember a few years back when we had to go out to friends for a contribution to keep the association afloat. Most can remember our almost-fatal illness two years ago when our yearbook publisher went Chapter 11 with our money in her pocket. Again, our friends and members put us back on our feet.

Perhaps, then, the most significant results of the 1987 National Doubles is that, in making major progress toward escaping the hand-to-mouth existence that has long been ours, we have the opportunity to instill a new sense of purpose in the Association, building on the momentum that the tournament has given us. Perhaps now we may dare to advance the ideas and programs that have been beyond our means. Specifically, we should now be able to mount an even more meaningful junior program that will assure the MSSRA's present and future. Perhaps we will be perceived as more "for real" by local squashers and administrative help will be easier to come by than in the past.

To all who contributed to the success of the 1987 National Doubles, a hearty thank you from the Maryland State Squash Racquets Association!
