

It takes a tremendous amount of effort to host a tournament of this size. I want to thank all of the volunteers and local clubs for their time and effort.





## WELCOME TO THE 1994 ROLEX SQUASH NATIONALS

This 12th U.S. National Soft Ball Championships truly represents a landmark event in American squash. The United States Squash Racquets Association, as nearly every squash player knows, is the national governing body for our sport and has hosted national singles squash championships in the U.S. for several decades (in fact, nearly back to the turn of the century). What not everyone realizes, however, are the relatively recent beginnings of *this* national tournament, or the dramatic increase in participation and importance of this championship in recent years. Simply based on numbers, in fact, and despite all the national and international events sponsored by and participated in by the USSRA and its members over the course of the year, it would be hard to argue that this is not *the* American national singles championship.



The first U.S. national soft ball singles tournament was played here in Baltimore in 1983, when the Maryland State Squash Racquets Association hosted seventy-seven competitors on traditional hard ball courts at the Baltimore Country Club. Since then, the tournament by any measure—participants, sponsorship, competitiveness, budget, influence—can only be called explosive. A year ago in San Francisco I wrote that that tournament was a watershed, because its tremendous size, popularity and superb organization presaged a permanent and arguably dominant place for soft ball in America's national squash competitions. This great tournament we celebrate in Baltimore this weekend—a year later, a continent away, with over six hundred entrants more or less evenly divided from among all the major playing centers of the U.S. and elsewhere—firmly cements the permanent importance of this national championship, and is a landmark event for that reason.

We wish to thank Ken and Anne Katz and their tournament committee members listed in this program for their leadership and efforts over well more than a year's time to make this such a great tournament. Meadow Mill Athletic Club, among a total of six facilities, has been more than generous in allowing us to visit and play in such a spectacular setting. We are indebted to Andersen Marketing, Hugh Anderson, the Baltimore Area Acura Dealers, Holabird Sports, Pierce-Leahy, The Omni and Radisson Hotels, CRS Corporation, Legg Mason and Keating Building Corporation and to all the individual and other corporate patrons listed here who have contributed their resources to the tournament's success. 
## S.L. GREEN CHAMPIONSHIPS

**T**his year's S.L. Green, a premier squash tournament now in its fifth year, will feature top-ranked professionals and amateurs alike, competing for prize money totaling \$17,200.

Conceived by New York real-estate executive Stephen L. Green, the tournament began play in 1990. A generous endowment established by Mr. Green has enabled the United States Squash Racquets Association (USSRA) to put on this elite event each year in conjunction with the U.S. Softball Nationals. While the coinciding Nationals determine top players in various age and ability categories ("age fifty and above" or "B" level for example), the primary purpose of the S.L. Green is to crown a national squash champion.

Accordingly, the winner, along with the top five finishers behind him, earns a spot on the exclusive U.S. tryout team for the World Squash Federation (WSF) Team Championships and the annual Pan American Federation Champions, the U.S. Women's Closed event helps determine which women will represent the U.S. in their World Championships.

The S.L. Green National Closed championship is a tourna-



ment where proven winners meet the next generation of superstars. With the rapidly growing appeal of the softball game in the U.S., the USSRA sees the need to support such a tournament. Mr. Green's vision has evolved into an awe-inspiring showcase which is expected to be a mainstay of the squash world for years to come.







## THE U.S. WOMEN'S WORLD TEAM UPDATE

**T**he U.S. Women's World Team now preparing for the World Championships to be held in Guernsey, England in October is the most experienced team yet to represent the United States in international competition. After a week of head-to-head matches in April, Demer Holleran, Ellie Pierce, Alicia McConnell, Karen Kelso and first alternate Shabana Khan were selected to the U.S. Women's World Team.

Each of these players has played for the U.S. as a World Team member in prior championships. As the standard bearer for the U.S. in international competition, with the highest team finish and individual rankings of all the U.S. teams, the women's team expects to maintain its high standard of play under the tutelage of Craig Thorp-Clarke, Team Coach and USSRA Director of Coaching.

The 1994 team members each has a distinctive style of play and brings different strengths onto the court. Demer Holleran, defending National Softball Champion, holder of the 1994 Hardball Singles, Women's Doubles and Mixed Doubles Championships and 1994 World Doubles Champion with Alicia McConnell, will lead the team into competition with her remarkable shot-making. 1991 National Softball Champion Ellie Pierce is expected to challenge her international competitors with her fitness and athletic style. The

team has been strengthened by the return to competition of Alicia McConnell, holder of a record eight National Hardball Championships and the highest world ranking (#12) of any U.S. player. Tenacity and determination are the hallmarks of Karen Kelso's game, while Shabana Khan's classic technique and knowledge of the game make her a tough competitor.


All of the U.S. Women's World Team Members have worked hard over a number of years to become more competitive in the international game. In addition to their on-court training, they have devoted significant time and energy to continuing the development program for the women's game that was established in 1991 and to raising money to fund the program. They have also learned to maintain that tough balance of being a team member in an individual sport where your opponent on-court is the same person who stands beside you at a World Team Championship.




