


U.S. SQUASH ATIONAL DOUBLES CHAMPIONSHIPS

United States National Doubles Championships March 26 – 28, 2010

Welcome to the 75th United States Squash National Men's and Women's Doubles Championships.

A national tournament requires many volunteers, sponsors and patrons who do the work; and by their patronage, offset the cost.

Player racquet fees account for only a third of the money needed. In 1996, the last time the national tournament came to Baltimore, your contributions and those of your companies made possible what was then considered the most successful US Nationals ever.

Baltimore 2010 will be the twelfth time Maryland State Squash has had the opportunity to manage the national tournament since its inception in 1933. In March 2010, 140 teams will travel to Baltimore from all over the United States and Canada to compete in the largest, most prestigious squash doubles event in North America. In addition to the men's and women's open championships there are veteran (40+), senior (50+), master (60+) and super senior (70+) age divisions. There is a Friday night dinner reception, Saturday lunch, Saturday night banquet and dance and daily light fare breakfast. For the players, national championships and team rankings are at stake. For Sponsors, Patrons and Guests there is great squash to watch and numerous events to enjoy.
